

Creating an Account in Cloud CME to receive CME credit

You should have already registered through the University of Tennessee system for the Developing Medical and Entomological Networks to Assist Individuals with Suspected Delusional Infestations (DI) conference.

NOTE: The Cloud CME system works best when using Google Chrome on a laptop or computer, but if you prefer to use your cellphone, you can download the Cloud CME app.

Please create your Cloud CME account using this link:

Select the *SIGN IN* tab in the upper left corner of the navy-blue bar.

Select *Sign-in with your Email and Password* on the right.

Select *Create New Account*.

Enter your *Email, First Name, and Last Name*.

Create a *Password*, then *confirm your Password*.

Select the appropriate *Degree and Profession* from the dropdown options.

Check the box that says *I have read and consent to the above*.

Select *Create Account*.

Since you will be completing a post-test and an evaluation in Cloud CME, please make a note of your log in information. You will receive an email after the conference with instructions to complete the requirements for credit.

Your certificate will be available in your Cloud CME account for 3 months after the conference; and your credits will always be available on your transcript under the Transcript tab.
